

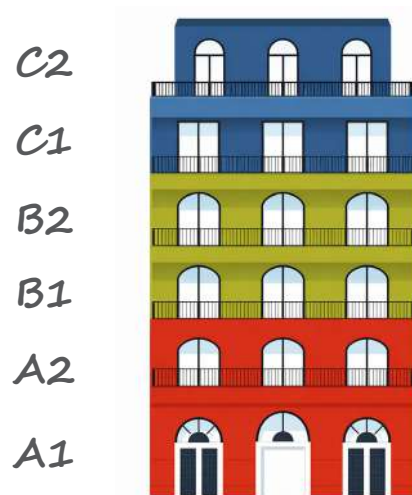
OUR METHODOLOGY

Since 2001, Speakeasy BCN has been helping students from around the world to learn Spanish with outstanding results thanks to the CASA program, our teaching method based on the Cervantes Institute curricular plan.

Imagine learning Spanish as building a house, floor by floor.

You can't build the next floor until the one below is solid. That's why our CASA program is structured into six floors and 13 courses. Each floor corresponds to one of the six levels of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, guiding you from complete beginner to advanced Spanish.

The Speakeasy teaching method is based on a modern immersion philosophy: all classes and materials are in Spanish. From day one, you're encouraged to listen, speak, read, and write exclusively in the language you're learning, so Spanish becomes natural, not translated.



A1

Floor 1: Beginner

Lay the foundation of Spanish. Understand simple phrases, ask basic questions, and handle everyday tasks like ordering food, shopping, or booking accommodation.

Example: "Una mesa para dos, por favor."
(A table for two, please.)

A2

Floor 2: Elementary

Talk about your past and future, express opinions and feelings, and manage simple social interactions with confidence.

Example: "El año pasado viajé a Sevilla y me encantó la ciudad."
(Last year I traveled to Seville and I loved the city.)

B1

Floor 3: Intermediate

Move beyond survival Spanish. Share stories, describe experiences, and express opinions

Example: "Si tengo más tiempo, estudiaré otro idioma también."
(If I have more time, I will study another language too.)

B2

Floor 4: Upper Intermediate

Speak fluently on a wide range of topics, follow conversations, films, and articles, and use idioms and figurative language naturally.

Example: "Aunque no comparto tu opinión, reconozco que tus argumentos son muy sólidos."
(Although I don't share your opinion, I recognize that your arguments are very strong.)

C1

Floor 5: Advanced

Handle complex ideas, fast conversations, and express yourself precisely in social, academic, and professional contexts

Example: "No es oro todo lo que reluce, pero esta experiencia me ha abierto muchas puertas."
(All that glitters is not gold, but this experience has opened many doors for me.)

C2

Floor 6: Proficient

Achieve native-like mastery. Understand everything with ease and express yourself effortlessly with nuance in any context.

Example: "El matiz de sus palabras revela una visión profundamente arraigada en la cultura española."
(The nuance of his words reveals a vision deeply rooted in Spanish culture.)

LONG-TERM SPANISH COURSES

Our Long-term Spanish courses are a great option if you want to learn Spanish and enjoy living in Barcelona for a longer period of time. These courses meet the requirements to apply for a student visa in Spain.

Choose between accelerated and immersive programs depending on your preference of schedule and learning goals.

Immersive Long-term Course

Our Immersive Long-Term Spanish Course (20h/week) offers a structured learning path with extra support through daily reinforcement workshops to help build your confidence over time. This program is ideal for students who want a more balanced pace and greater flexibility during their stay in Spain.

In total, you'll study 10 hours of core Spanish lessons + 10 hours of Spanish reinforcement workshops per week. During the first 12 weeks (A1 to A2 levels), workshops are based on themes like pronunciation, daily life vocabulary, and cultural immersion. From B1 onward, workshops shift to Conversation & Culture classes for more in-depth speaking practice and cultural immersion.

You'll attend 20 hours of structured group Spanish classes per week, covering up to 6 levels of the CASA program. Among our four long-term options, this is our most popular course, thanks to its focused schedule and fast learning pace.

You'll complete a level every two weeks, since all four daily hours are dedicated to structured group lessons that follow our proven CASA curriculum.

Afternoon Immersive Spanish 20h Long-term Course

Our Afternoon Immersive Program offers the same balanced approach to Spanish learning as our midday Immersive course, but with a later schedule and a fixed academic calendar for students committed to a full-year stay in Spain.

Schedule, Monday through Friday:

- **General Spanish Classes: 17:30 – 19:30**
- **Spanish Reinforcement Workshops: 15:30 – 17:30**

In total, you'll study 10 hours of core Spanish lessons + 10 hours of workshops per week. During the first 12 weeks (A1 to A2 levels), workshops cover a variety of rotating topics such as pronunciation and speaking fluency, everyday vocabulary and life skills in Spain, listening comprehension through media and real-world materials and practical grammar in context. You can attend these workshops based on your interests and language needs. From B1 onward, workshops shift to Conversation and Culture classes for more in-depth speaking practice and cultural immersion.

Only available as a 1 year (52-week) program. Holiday weeks are set by the school and take place in August and December.

Evening Spanish 20h Long-term Course

The Evening 20h Long-Term Spanish Course is designed for students who want to study Spanish in Barcelona while maintaining daytime responsibilities. With evening classes and engaging language support sessions, this program offers a complete, immersive Spanish learning experience that is fully eligible for a student visa.

Schedule:

- **General Spanish Classes: Two evenings per week, either Monday and Wednesday or Tuesday and Thursday, from 18:00 to 20:00**
- **Spanish Reinforcement Workshops: Monday to Friday, from 14:30 to 17:30**

Your structured evening classes focus on grammar, speaking, listening, reading, and writing. The course also includes daily Spanish reinforcement workshops, fulfilling the 20-hour weekly requirement for the student visa. The Spanish reinforcement workshops are interactive, teacher-led sessions that focus on helping you gain fluency and confidence in real-life Spanish. These workshops cover a variety of rotating topics such as pronunciation and speaking fluency, everyday vocabulary and life skills in Spain, listening comprehension through media and real-world materials and practical grammar in context.

Only available as a 1 year (52-week) program. Holiday weeks are set by the school and take place in August and December.

YOUR HOME AWAY FROM HOME

Speakeasy BCN is partnered with local accommodation providers in order to offer our students a variety of options. Most are located within 20 minutes from the school and the city center by public transport.

Student residence

In a student residence you'll have a private room with different bed and amenities options you can choose from. Bookings can include only accommodation, breakfast and dinner, or all meals in a residence cafeteria.

Also included are a variety of other student services such as a gym, study areas, rooftop terrace, media room, laundry room and more!T

Shared apartment

A shared apartment means that you have your own room in a shared apartment with other students. This option is more suited to our longer-term students. Normally, you live with 1-2 other students. You will have your own room with a desk, closet, your own keys and access to all shared areas of the flat. Food is not included, but will have a shared kitchen to cook your own meals. All the apartments have a Wifi connection, linens, and cleaning service included.

Having a private apartment means that you will have an entire centrally located apartment to yourself. Our partners offer a wide portfolio of private apartments with the highest standards. All of them fully furnished, equipped and nicely decorated.

Minimum stay: 1 month

Local host

A local host s an excellent way to practice your Spanish and experience Spanish culture firsthand. You will have your own room with a desk and closet, and your own set of keys. The laundry and cleaning are included. You will have the option to include breakfast and dinner if you prefer. All the apartments have a Wifi connection and include linens.
